CONDUCTING THE ONLINE END SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS OF 4th and 2nd SEMESTER STUDENTS OF M.Sc. MATHEMATICS/STATISTICS AT DEPARTMENT LEVEL FOR EVEN SEMESTER 2020

As per the academic council meeting with ref. no. CUPB/CC/COE/2020/139, dated 10th July-2020, End Sem. Exams are to be conducted at Department level. The following instructions are to be followed during the online examination.

- 1. Online end semester examinations will be conducted by the course coordinator at the department level for the 4th and 2nd semester students of M.Sc. Mathematics/Statistics.
- 2. Course coordinators have to prepare fresh list of MCQ questions for end sem. Exams.
- The course coordinator may choose the appropriate platform to conduct the online exam as the Google form/Microsoft Team/ Class maker for the end semester exam.
- The schedule for online end semester examinations of 4th and 2nd semester students of M.Sc. Mathematics/Statistics is as given below:

- 10. The option of showing the correct and missing answers should be deactivated.
- 11. The scores of the exams should not be released to the students.
